

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

PART OF RESTRICTED BYWAY NO.1125 WOODHALL SPA

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2022

On 09 April 2025 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to extinguish the full width of Restricted Byway 1125 in the parish of Woodhall Spa commencing on the western side of the former railway on the river Witham's eastern bank at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TF 1750 6239 (A), running in a generally east north easterly direction over a grass field for approximately 30 metres to OSGR TF 1753 6241 (B). Here it turns in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 53 metres to OSGR TF 1756 6245 (C). Here it joins a track on the northern side of the ditch, along which it continues in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 157 metres to OSGR TF 1772 6249 (D). The way then crosses the property 59 Mill Lane in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 42 metres until it meets the public highway Mill Lane at OSGR TF 1776 6250 (E). The total length of extinguished footpath is approximately 282 metres as shown between points A-B-C-D-E on Order drawing numbered 2022/013/PPO376/A4.

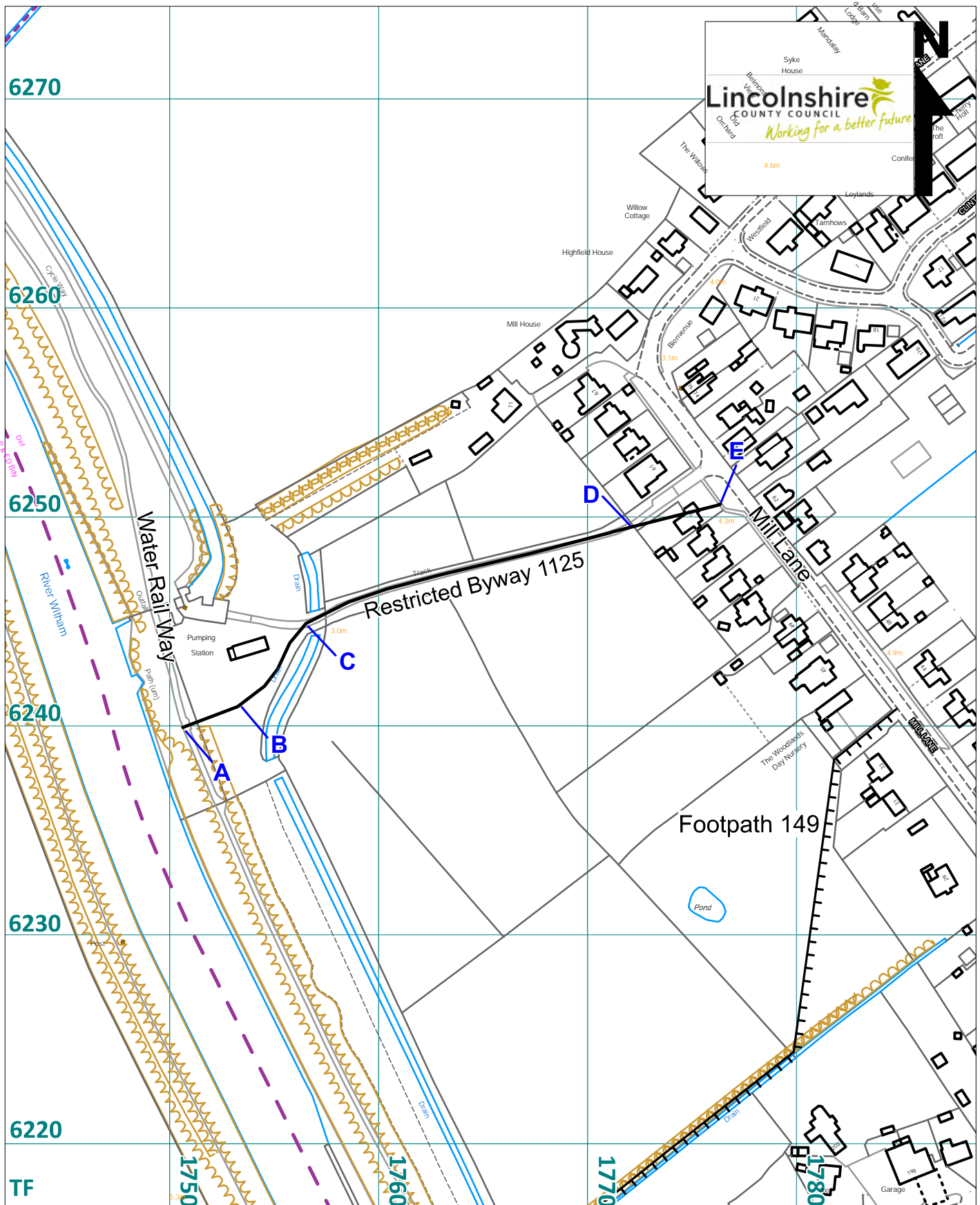

PUBLIC PATH CREATION ORDER 2022

On 09 April 2025 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to create Public Bridleway No.1207 in the parish of Woodhall Spa at 3 metres wide commencing at the Water Rail Way at TF 1750 6239 (A) and running in a generally east north easterly direction over a grass field for approximately 30 metres to OSGR TF 1753 6241 (B) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 53 metres to OSGR TF 1756 6245 (C) then running in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 145 metres through a pasture field to OSGR TF 1770 6249 (D) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 53 metres to the boundary of the field and then along a surfaced access road between Nos. 59 and 61 Mill Lane to terminate at the highway, Mill Lane, at OSGR TF 1775 6252 (E). The total length of bridleway to be added to be approximately 281 metres as shown between points A-B-C-D-E on Order drawing 2022/014/PPO376/A4. Limitation at OSGR TF 1750 6239 (Point G1), OSGR TF 1757 6245 (Point G2) and at OSGR TF 1771 6250 (Point G3) - Bridle gate compliant to BS5709:2018.

On 09 April 2025 the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to create Public Bridleway No.1207 in the parish of Woodhall Spa at 3 metres wide commencing at the Water Rail Way at TF 1750 6239 (A) and running in a generally east north easterly direction over a grass field for approximately 30 metres to OSGR TF 1753 6241 (B) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 53 metres to OSGR TF 1756 6245 (C) then running in a generally east north easterly direction for approximately 145 metres through a pasture field to OSGR TF 1770 6249 (D) then continuing in a generally north easterly direction for approximately 53 metres to the boundary of the field and then along a surfaced access road between Nos. 59 and 61 Mill Lane to terminate at the highway, Mill Lane, at OSGR TF 1775 6252 (E). The total length of bridleway to be added to be approximately 281 metres as shown between points A-B-C-D-E on Order drawing 2022/014/PPO376/A4. Limitation at OSGR TF 1750 6239 (Point G1), OSGR TF 1757 6245 (Point G2) and at OSGR TF 1771 6250 (Point G3) - Bridle gate compliant to BS5709:2018.

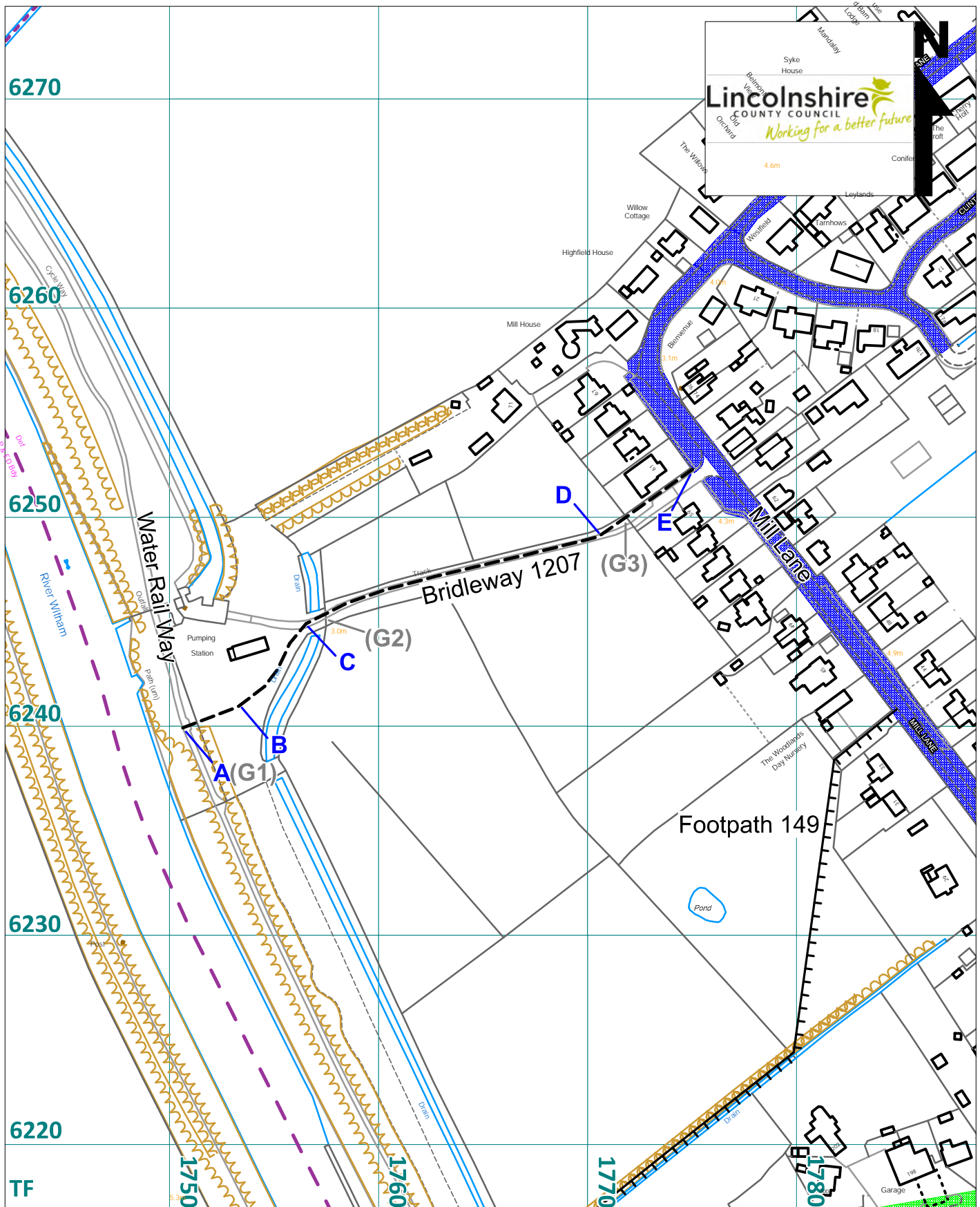
