
PERMEABLE PAVING Typical Plan for Carriageway Bindercourse Drilling



Notes

- 1. Holes drilled at 750mm centres in rows 750mm apart evenly spaced across the carriageway.
- The distance from the kerb face to the first row of holes will vary, see examples below:
- Each row offset by 375mm as per drawing.
- Cleanliness is essential. All water, slurry and debris to be mechanically removed fro the holes to leave clean sub base (eg. a wet/dry vacuum appliance).

Road width (m)	Distance to centre of first row of holes from kerb face (mm)	Number of rows
5.0	625	7
5.5	500	8
