

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(PINCHBECK – VARIOUS ROADS)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Pinchbeck – Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 20
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions at the above location.
- Investigations have shown that parking along this length of road is frequently causing congestion. Large vehicles are often forced to mount the pavement because of parked cars, and forward visibility is poor due to the bend in the road. As a result, drivers must commit to their manoeuvre without being able to see oncoming traffic, creating a road safety concern.
- To address these issues, it is proposed to introduce parking restrictions along the affected section. A small area of on-street parking will remain in the vicinity of 42–44 Knight Street to provide natural traffic calming and to support the two businesses located there. Other businesses and the majority of residents in the area have access to private off-street parking, and it is not anticipated that the proposals will have a significant adverse impact.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Pinchbeck Parish Council and South Holland District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting on the southern side of Knight Street between Church Street and Guildhall Drive, with the exception of a small length of road in the vicinity of nos. 42 and 44 Knight Street. No Waiting at Any Time is also proposed at the junctions of Knight Street/Bear Lane and Knight Street/Guildhall Drive.


Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
