

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(WADDINGTON – VALLEY ROAD & CEDAR CLOSE)**  
**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20**

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on \_\_\_\_\_ 20\_\_ and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Waddington – Valley Road & Cedar Close) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 20\_\_
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Investigations have identified ongoing issues with inconsiderate and unsafe parking around junctions in this area. Such practices are obstructing the free flow of traffic and creating significant road safety concerns. However, evidence indicates that this problem is concentrated at particular times of the day, and feedback from residents has highlighted the need for some on street parking availability outside these peak periods.
  
- The revised restrictions will continue to prevent vehicles from parking opposite the bus stop at any time, as parking in this location reduces visibility for all road users and contributes to delays in all directions due to its close proximity to the junction. The bus stop clearway will ensure unrestricted access for scheduled bus services by prohibiting the stopping, waiting and loading of any vehicle except a bus. The clearway will be in operation between the hours of 6am – midnight daily.
  
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
  
- The Chief Constable, Waddington Parish Council and North Kesteven District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the Schedule below.

- Introduce no waiting at any time on Valley Road opposite the bus stop & at the junction of Cedar Close.
- Introduce no waiting Mon-Fri 8-9.30am & 2-4.30pm along Valley Road up to Cedar Close junction on both sides of the road from bus stop & no waiting at any time restrictions
- Introduce a Bus Stop Clearway daily 6am-Midnight


Some exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
