

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(SPALDING – VARIOUS ROADS)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 20

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on **2nd February 2026** and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Spalding - Various Roads) (Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Order 20
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan TF246226 TF246227 TF247226 TF247227 TF248226 TF248225 of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

6. This Order shall remain in force for a maximum of 18 months from its date of operation.

(SPALDING - VARIOUS ROADS)

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 20

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) and 3(2) Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on **2nd February 2026** and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Spalding – Various Roads) (Prohibition of Driving) Experimental Order 20
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed on any road or length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order between the hours of 10.00am to 4.00pm, Monday to Saturday inclusive.
3. Nothing in Article 2 shall render it unlawful for a person to cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed on any road or length of road specified in the Schedule, if the vehicle is:-
 - (a) for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes;
 - (b) granted special written exemption by Lincolnshire County Council.
 - (c) a purpose built or specially adapted security vehicle which by distinctive external markings and/or trade signs may be easily identified as a security vehicle, operated by uniformed security personnel and which is being used for the purpose of delivery or collection of:
 - (i) bullion or
 - (ii) substantial quantities of money in the form of cash or
 - (iii) high value commodities

- (d) Other than a privately owned vehicle, any which is being used as an official vehicle for the purpose of a wedding or funeral at a Church or place of worship.
- (e) In the service of a local authority, water undertaker or sewage undertaker in connection with work being carried out on, or on land adjacent to that length of road in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

4. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on any road or length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
6. The Order cited as Lincolnshire County Council (Spalding – Various Roads) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2025, is hereby revoked in its entirety.

SCHEDULE 1 Prohibition of Driving (Except for Access)

Bridge Street

From its junction with Double Street in a northerly direction to its junction with Market Place.

Broad Street

From its junction with Herring Lane in a southerly direction to its junction with Market Place.

Hall Place

For its entirety.

Market Place

For its entirety.

Red Lion Street

From the northern property boundary No 3 Red Lion Street in a southerly direction to its junction with Market Place.

Sheep Market

From its junction with Hall Place in a westerly direction for 55 metres.

SCHEDULE 2 Prohibition of Driving

Sheep Market

At its junction with Hall Place in an easterly direction for a distance of 5 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- The County Council recently introduced a number of Traffic Regulation Orders (TROs) in Spalding Town Centre that restricted both access and parking.
- Following the implementation of the scheme, it has been requested that the parking restrictions are relaxed on the above roads to allow for parking to take place before 10am and after 4pm.
- This will be achieved by way of an experimental Order to allow for the changes to be monitored before Lincolnshire County Council consider whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely.
- An Experimental TRO will be in place from 2nd February 2026 for a period of at least six months and the extent of the proposal is detailed on the attached plan and I would be grateful to receive your comments by 29th July 2026.
- The Chief Constable and South Holland District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council has made two Orders under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose an Experimental Order which will prevent access/parking/loading between the hours of 10am to 4pm, Monday to Saturday and allow access/parking/loading to take place in the Market Place, Bridge Street and Hall Place before 10am and after 4pm, Monday to Saturday. There will be no restrictions in place on a Sunday.


The Order will come into operation on **2nd February 2026** and a copy of the proposed Order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned with a Statement of Reasons may be inspected at the address given below and the offices of South Holland District Council, during normal office hours.

Representations or objections to the proposals, together with the grounds on which they are made, must be made in writing to Chief Executive - Lincolnshire County Council, Lancaster House, 36 Orchard Street, Lincoln, LN1 1XX or Email: TRO@lincolnshire.gov.uk (For the attention of: Mrs J Gibson, Traffic Orders Section) by **29th July 2026**

Lincolnshire County Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Order should continue in force indefinitely together with any representations or objections received.

Any person who desires to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks after **26th January 2026** make application to the High Court for this purpose.




