

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119**

**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 3 BUTTERWICK**

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

On 2 January 2026 Lincolnshire County Council confirmed the above-named Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the full width of part Butterwick Public Footpath No.3 running OSGR TF 3874 4445 (A) in a generally southerly direction for approximately 4m to OSGR TF 3874 4444 (B) then continuing in a generally westerly direction for approximately 130m to OSGR TF 3861 4443 (C) then running in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 35m to OSGR TF 3862 4440 (D) then continuing in a generally west south westerly to curve westerly around The Old Girls School building for approximately 56m to terminate at Girls School Lane OSGR TF 3856 4439 (E). The total length of footpath diverted is approximately 225m as shown between points A-B-C-D-E on Order drawing numbered 2025/016/PPO387/A4 TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Butterwick to be a 2m wide footpath running from Butterwick Footpath No.3 at OSGR TF 3874 4445 (A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 178m to terminate at Girls School Lane OSGR TF 3856 4443 (F). The total length of footpath added is approximately 178m as shown between points A-F on Order drawing numbered 2025/016/PPO387/A4.

Any person who wishes to claim compensation under section 28 as applied by section 121(2) of the 1980 Act for depreciation or damage for disturbance arising as a result of the coming into force of the Order must make a claim in writing addressed to Legal Services Lincolnshire, Floor 4, Orchard House, Lincoln, LN1 1BA, marked for the attention of Sally Ironmonger quoting reference SXI.74679.BUTTERWICK and serve it by delivering it at, or sending it by prepaid post to, that address not later than 31 July 2026. A copy of the sections is attached.

The Order comes into force as from 30 January 2026 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 21 January 2026 make an application to the High Court.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Boston Borough Council has been consulted as to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Butterwick and shown by a bold continuous line on the drawing contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Butterwick described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the drawing contained in this Order.

### PART1

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

##### In the Parish of Butterwick

The full width of part Butterwick Public Footpath No.3 running OSGR TF 3874 4445 (A) in a generally southerly direction for approximately 4m to OSGR TF 3874 4444 (B) then continuing in a generally westerly direction for approximately 130m to OSGR TF 3861 4443 (C) then running in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 35m to OSGR TF 3862 4440 (D) then continuing in a generally west south westerly to curve westerly around The Old Girls School building for approximately 56m to terminate at Girls School Lane OSGR TF 3856 4439 (E). The total length of footpath diverted is approximately 225m as shown between points A-B-C-D-E on annexed drawing numbered 2025/016/PPO387/A4.

### PART 2

#### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

##### In the Parish of Butterwick

A 2m wide footpath running from Butterwick Footpath No.3 at OSGR TF 3874 4445 (A) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 178m to terminate at Girls School Lane OSGR TF 3856 4443 (F). The total length of footpath added is approximately 178m as shown between points A-F on annexed drawing numbered 2025/016/PPO387/A4.
