**DIVERSION OF PART OF WALESBY PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 120**

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

The above Order, made on 14 January 2026 under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the whole width of Public Footpath No.120 in the parish of Walesby commencing from the rear of Cliff House from OSGR TF13589202 (A) in a south south easterly direction for approximately 106m to terminate at Catskin Lane OSGR TF13639192 (B). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 106m as shown between points A-B on Order drawing numbered 2025/014/PPO388/A4 TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Walesby to be a 2m wide public footpath running from the rear of Cliff House at OSGR TF13589202 (A) in a generally easterly direction curving to an east south easterly direction for approximately 33 metres to OSGR TF13619201 (C) then running in a southerly direction for approximately 82 metres to terminate at Catskin Lane OSGR TF13629193 (D). The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 115m as shown between points A-C-D on Order drawing numbered 2025/014/PPO388/A4. Limitation: OSGR TF 13589202 (Point A) – tall deer-proof kissing gate compliant to BS5709:2018.



**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2026**

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

West Lindsey District Council has been consulted as to the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Walesby and shown by a bold continuous line on the drawing contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 365 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.


2. There shall at the end of 365 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Walesby described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the drawing contained in this Order.
  
3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.





That whole width of Public Footpath No.120 commencing from the rear of Cliff House from OSGR TF13589202 (A) in a south south easterly direction for approximately 106m to terminate at Catskin Lane OSGR TF13639192 (B). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 106m as shown between points A-B on annexed drawing numbered 2025/014/PPO388/A4.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY**

##### **In the Parish of Walesby**

A 2 metre wide Public Footpath running from the rear of Cliff House at OSGR TF13589202 (A) in a generally easterly direction curving to an east south easterly direction for approximately 33 metres to OSGR TF13619201 (C) then running in a southerly direction for approximately 82 metres to terminate at Catskin Lane OSGR TF13629193 (D). The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 115m as shown between points A-C-D on annexed drawing numbered 2025/014/PPO388/A4.
