

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119**

**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 132 TEALBY**

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2025**

On 8 May 2026 Lincolnshire County Council confirmed the above-named Order. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the full width of Public Footpath No.132 in the parish of Tealby running from Sandy Lane at OSGR TF 1522 9009 (A) in a generally westerly, curving to north north westerly, direction within the curtilage of the property, The Old Pottery, for approximately 46 metres to OSGR TF 1518 9010 (B) then continuing within the rear garden in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 19 metres to a stile at OSGR TF 1517 9009 (C) then running beyond the garden cross-field in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 116 metres to terminate at OSGR TF 1507 9002 (D). The total length of diverted footpath is 181 metres as shown between Points A-B-C-D on Order Drawing No. 2025/022/PPO389/A4 (04/09/25) TO AN ALTERNATIVE ROUTE in the parish of Tealby to be a 2m wide public footpath running from Sandy Lane at OSGR TF 1523 9010 (E) in a generally westerly direction for approximately 52 metres to OSGR TF 1518 9010 (F) then continuing in a generally west south westerly direction for approximately 52 metres to OSGR TF 1513 9008 (G) then running in a generally south westerly direction for approximately cross-field in a generally south westerly direction for approximately 85 metres to terminate at OSGR TF 1507 9002 (D). The total length of added footpath is 189 metres as shown between Points E-F-G-D on Order Drawing No. 2025/022/PPO389/A4 (04/09/25). Limitation: OSGR TF 1513 9008 - Wicket gate compliant to BS5709:2018.

The Order comes into force as from 19 June 2026 but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 27 May 2026 make an application to the High Court.

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

West Lindsey District Council has been consulted as to the making of the Order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

**BY THIS ORDER:**

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Tealby and shown by a bold continuous line on the drawing contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 42 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 42 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Tealby described in Part 2 of the

Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the drawing contained in this Order.

3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

The total length of added footpath is 189 metres as shown between Points E-F-G-D on annexed Plan No. 2025/022/PPO389/A4 (04/09/25).

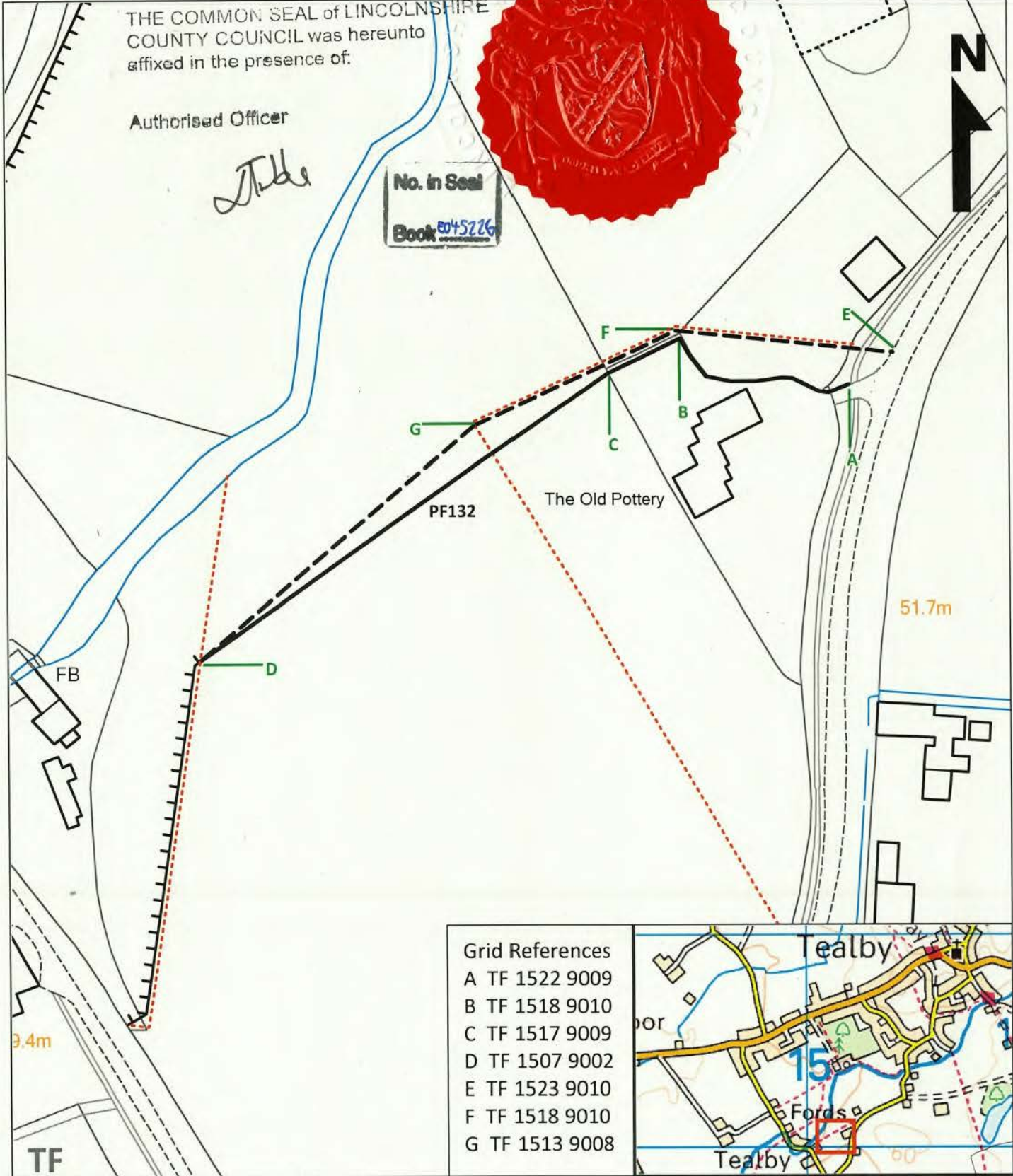

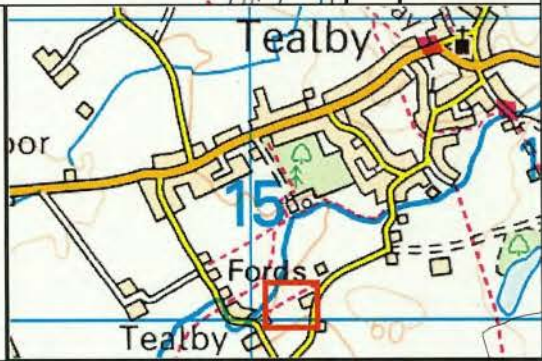
