

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**(30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20**

The LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Low Fulney – Weston Hills Road, Austendyke Road and Broadgate) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 20 and shall come into operation on.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road within the terminal points as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
5. Any existing restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths and sides of the roads specified in this Order.

## **SCHEDULE 1- 30MPH Within Terminal Points**

### **Austendyke Road**

422 metres east of its junction with Delgate Bank

580 metres east of its junction with Swindlers Drove

### **Broadgate**

227 metres north of its junction with Austendyke Road

### **Delgate Bank**

10 metres south of its junction with Austendyke Road

3 metres north of its junction with Austendyke Road

## **Schedule 2 – 40mph**

### **Weston Hills Road**

From a point 25 meters east of its junction with Fulney Drove in an easterly direction to a point 580metres east of its junction with Swindlers Drove

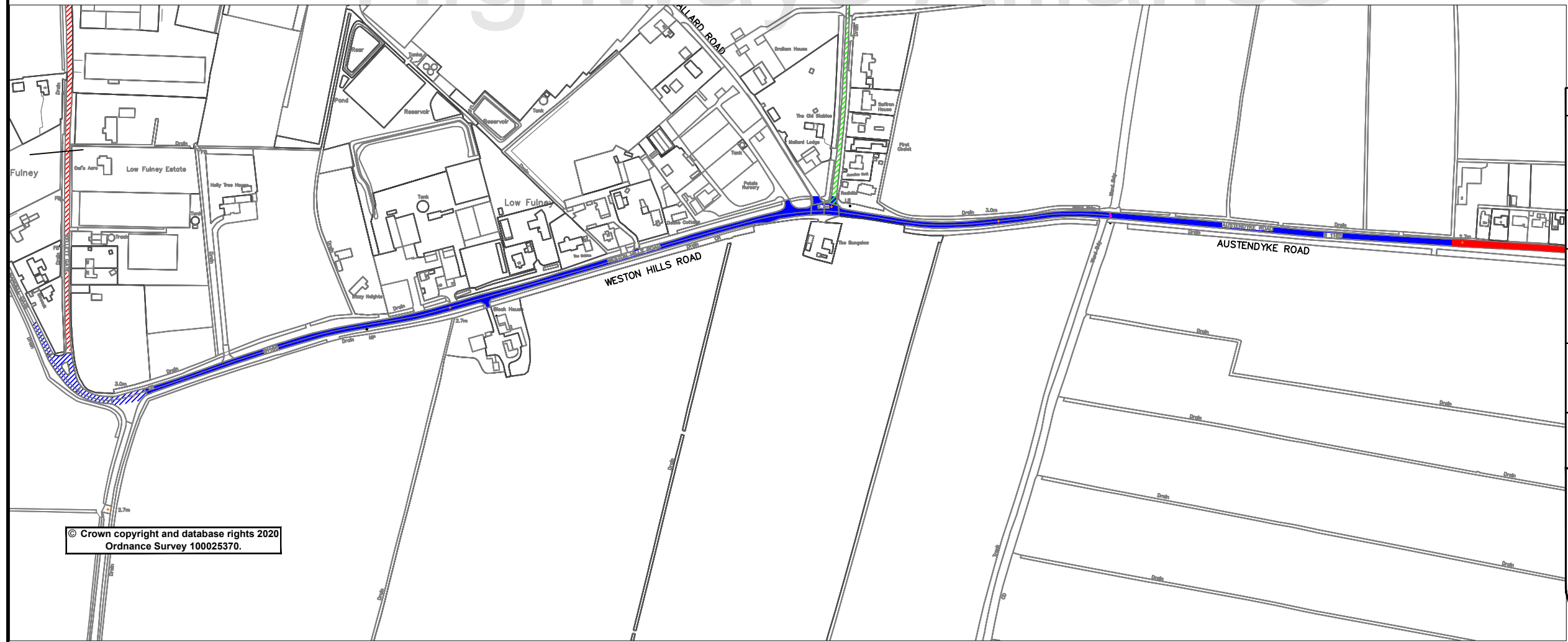
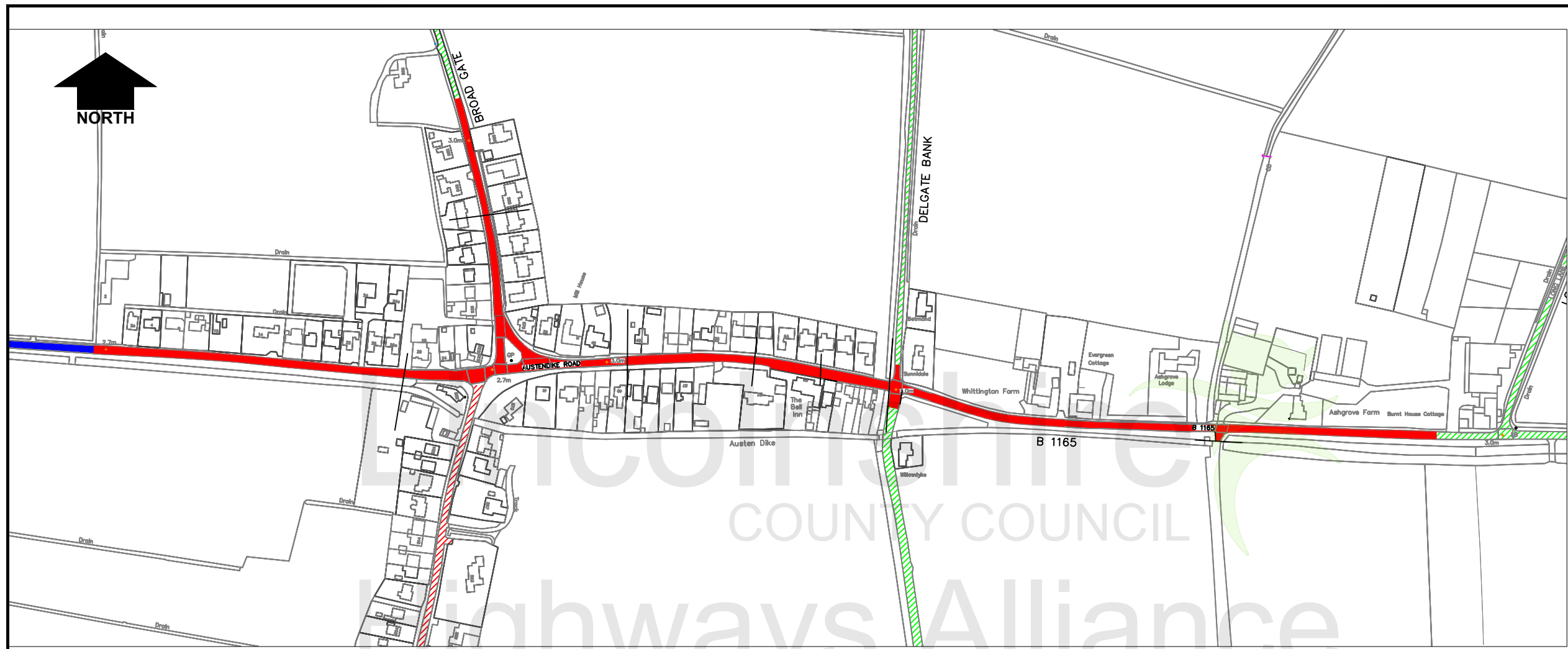
**STATEMENT OF REASONS**
