

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(LINCOLN – CALDER ROAD)**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2026**

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Lincoln – Calder Road) (Revocation of Waiting) Amendment Order 2026
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the schedule below:

- Change the existing mandatory school keep clears and part time restriction so they are in operation Monday – Friday 8-9.30am & 3-4.30pm
- Introduce No Waiting at Any Time outside properties 242-246, Calder Road
- Revoke existing restrictions outside properties 236-240.

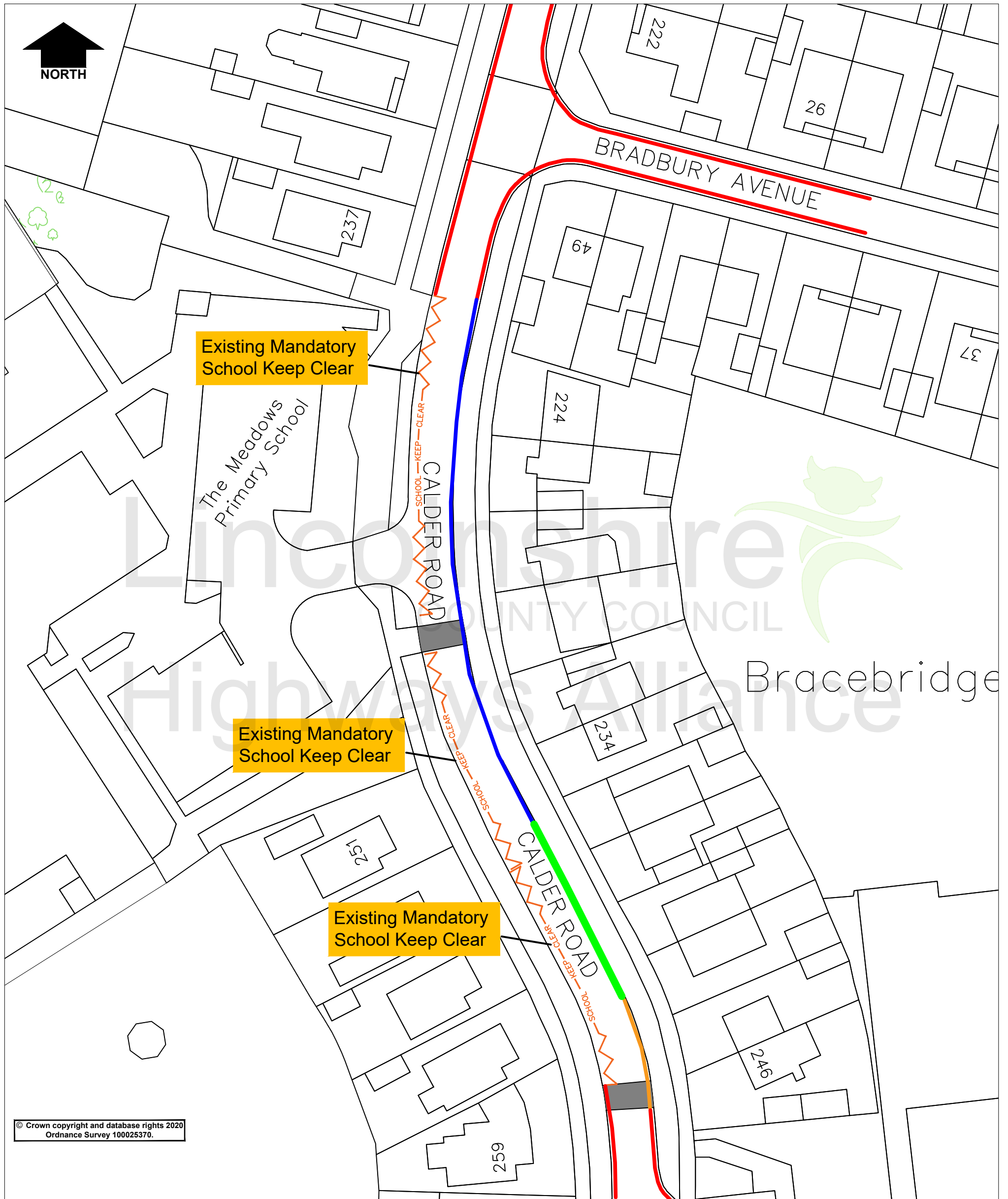

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions at the above location.
- Investigations have shown that there is a demand for on street parking outside The Meadows Primary School at school drop off/pick up times. To promote more balance between the needs of local residents and pedestrian safety it is proposed to revoke sections of the existing No Waiting Monday-Friday 8-9.30am and 2-4.30pm, change the existing times on the mandatory school keep clears and part time restrictions to Monday – Friday 8.00-9.30am and 3-4.30pm. It is also proposed to introduce no waiting at any time outside properties 242-246, Calder Road.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable and City of Lincoln Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
