

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING & LOADING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53,124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on _____ 20__ and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Lincoln – Carlton Boulevard, Venables Way & Reed Drive) (Prohibition of Waiting & Loading) Amendment Order 20
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING & LOADING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting and loading as set out in the Schedule below.

- To introduce mandatory school keep clear markings at the entrance of the school on Carlton Boulevard. To be in operation Mon-Fri 8-9.30am & 2.30-4pm. (The bus stop will be moved to another location).
- To introduce no loading restrictions Mon-Fri 8-9.30am & 2.30-4pm around the school on Carlton Boulevard, Venables Way and Reed Drive. The no waiting at any time restrictions remain unchanged on these roads.

Exemptions are included outside the no loading times which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

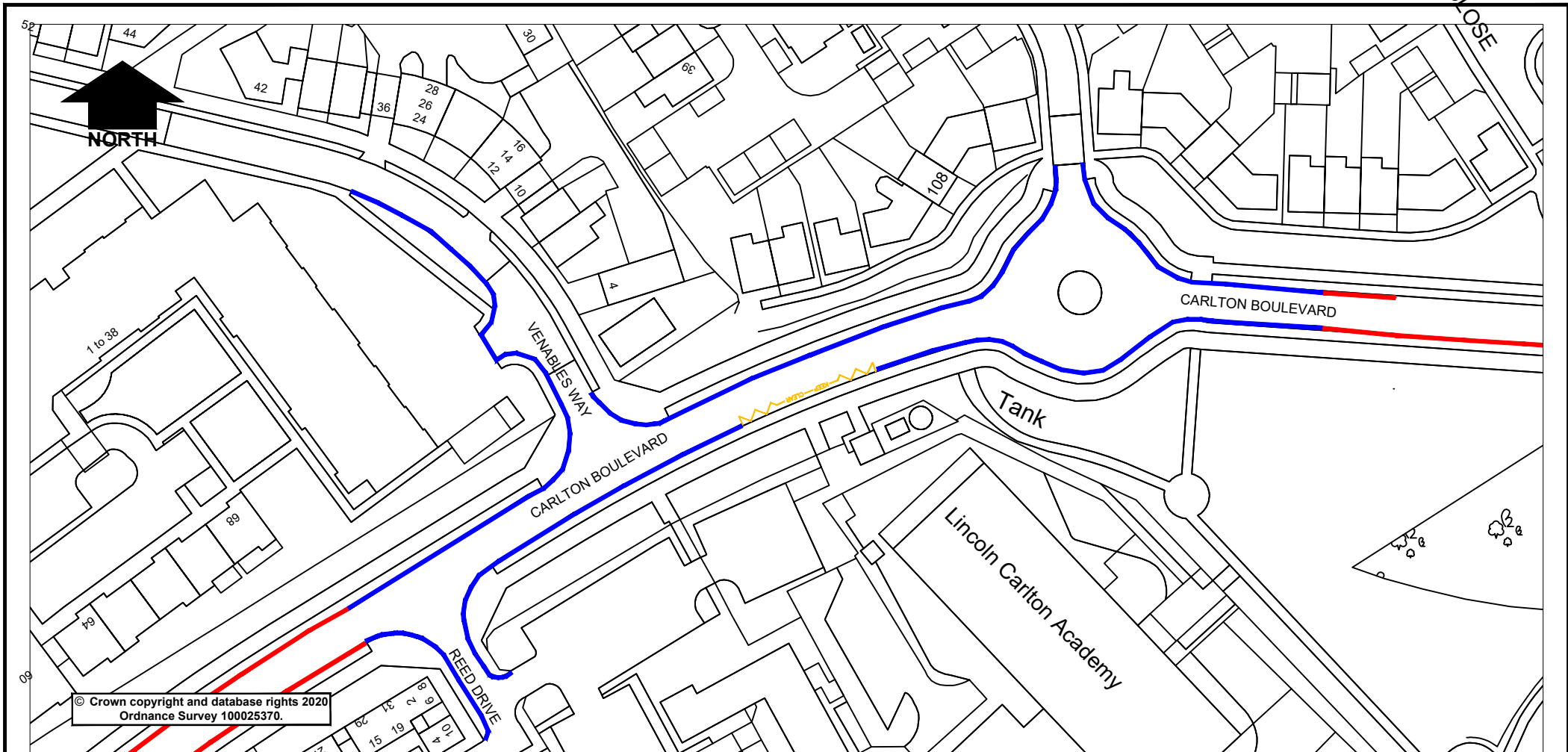

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Investigations have shown that vehicles are parking on the existing no waiting at any time restrictions around school drop off and pick up times. In order to enable Civil Enforcement Officers to issue Penalty Charge Notices without a five minute observation period the No Loading restrictions are being proposed. The existing no waiting at any time restrictions will remain.
- The existing bus stop close to the school entrance is being relocated and mandatory School Keep Clear markings are being proposed in the location to prevent vehicles parking at the entrance to the school and improve visibility for pedestrians crossing Carlton Boulevard.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Lincoln City Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
