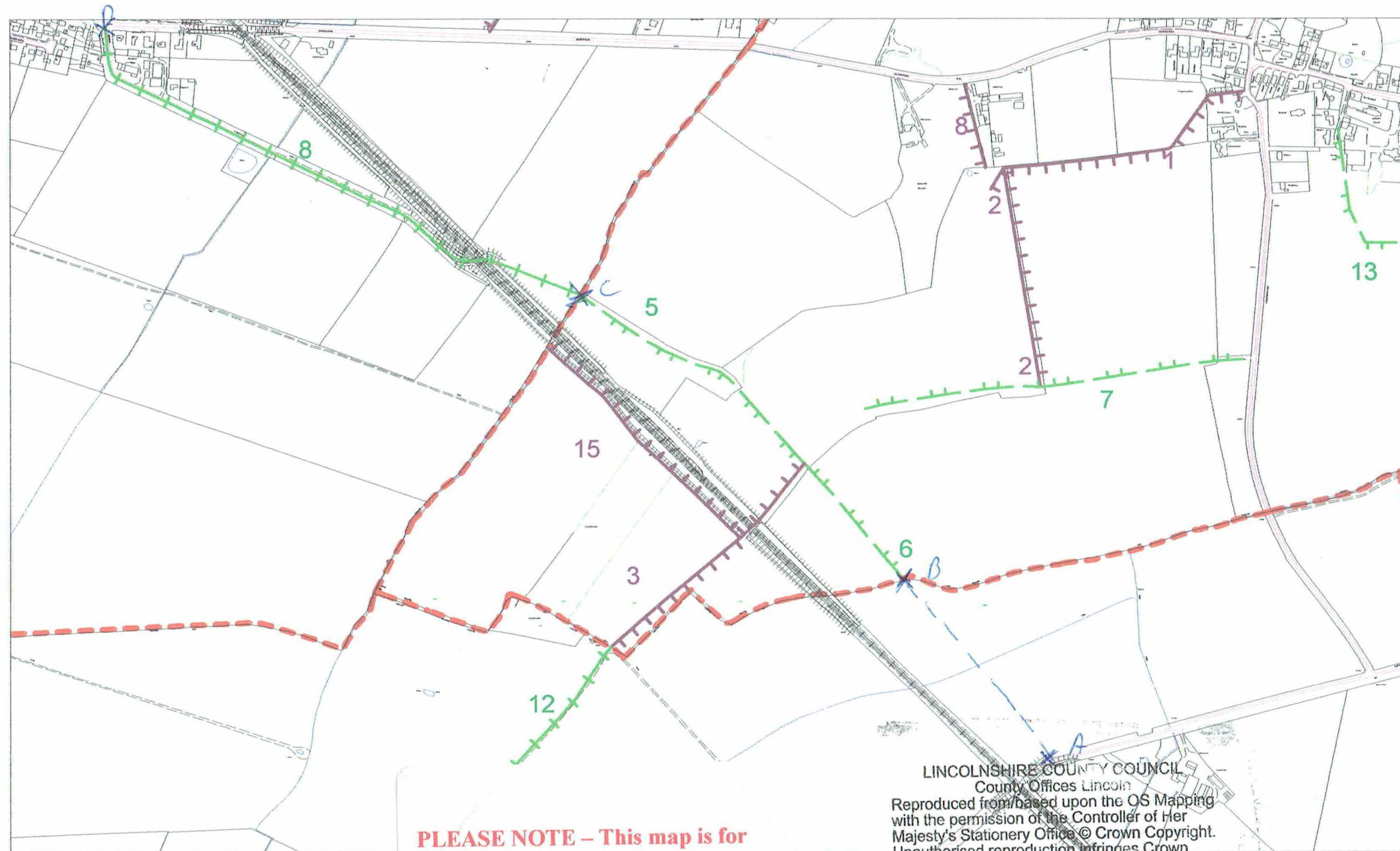

The above documents show Hough Road as a public carriage road from at least 1771 and being from Stubton Road in Claypole across Stubton ~~Par~~ Parish into Dry Doddington Parish to a point on Clensey Lane shown by an indent in the property boundary which is Point A on Clensey Lane.

From the above evidence Hough Road should be shown on the Definitive Map as a Byway Open to All Traffic.
