The LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Broadholme – School Lane, Saxilby Road, Manor Lane and Occupation Lane) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 20 and shall come into operation on.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. Any existing restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths and sides of the roads specified in this Order.

## **SCHEDULE - 30MPH**

### **School Lane**

From its junction with Saxilby Road/Manor Lane in a south westerly direction for 408 metres.

### **Saxilby Road**

From its junction of School Lane/Manor Road in a northerly direction for 246 metres.

### **Manor Lane**

From its junction with School Lane in a southerly direction for 630 metres to the end of maintainable highway.

### **Occupation Lane**

From its junction with Manor Lane in an easterly direction for 825 metres to the end of the maintainable highway.
