

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(AUBOURN AND HADDINGTON, VARIOUS ROADS)
(30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20

The LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of their powers under Sections 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Aubourn and Haddington, Various Roads) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 20 and shall come into operation on 20.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.

SCHEDULE – 30MPH

Aubourn, Church Road

From its junction with Bridge Road in an easterly direction for a distance of 220 metres.

Aubourn, Bassingham Road

From its junction with Bridge Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 250 metres.

Aubourn & Haddington, Bridge Road

For its entire length from its junction with South Hykeham Road, Haddington in a southerly direction to its junction with Church Road, Aubourn.

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STATEMENT OF REASONS

- When comparing the conditions to the current speed limit policy, a 30mph speed limit is recommended.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Councils Speed Limit Policy, it is proposed to introduce a speed limit as per the schedule to the Order.

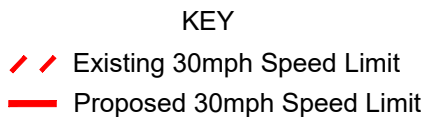
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to restrict the speed of vehicles to 30mph on Church Road from its junction with Bridge Road in an easterly direction for 220 metres, on Bassingham Road from its junction with Bridge Road in a westerly direction for 250 metres, and Bridge Road for its whole length.
