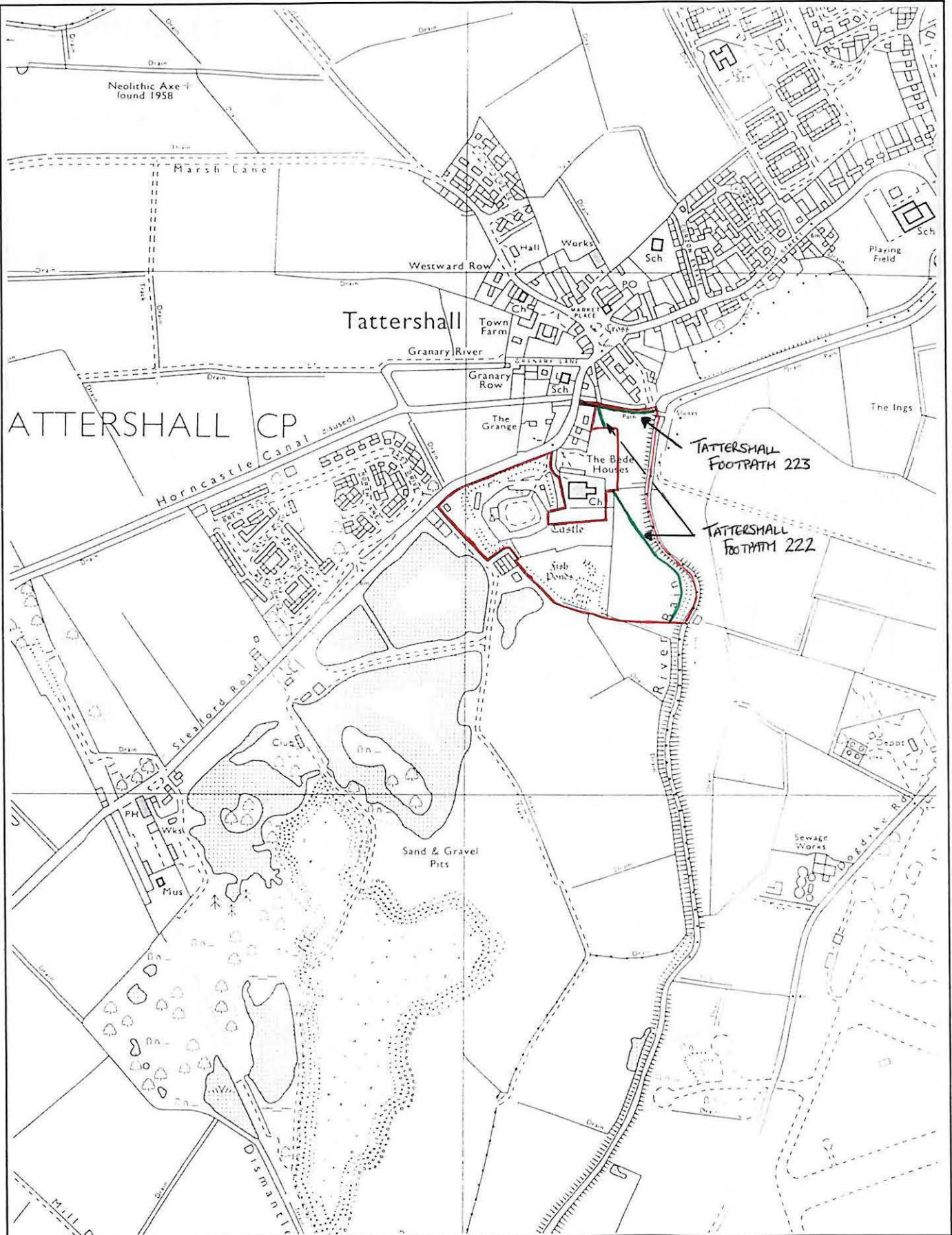
Tattershall Castle Rights of Way Lincolnshire County Council
