

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CHERRY WILLINGHAM – CROFT LANE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Cherry Willingham – Croft Lane) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 20
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHERRY WILLINGHAM – CROFT LANE) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 20

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be introduce:

- No Waiting at Any Time on sections of Croft Lane and Hawthorn Road.
- No Waiting & No Loading on the eastern side of Croft Lane Mon – Fri 8-9.30am and 2.30-4pm.
- Mandatory School Keep Clear markings adjacent to the school Mon – Fri 8-9.30am and 2.30-4pm.
- Bus Stop Clearways in the vicinity of properties 58 & 60 and in the layby adjacent to the school will ensure unrestricted access for scheduled bus services by prohibiting the stopping, waiting and loading of any vehicle except a bus. The clearways will be in operation between the hours of Mon-Fri 7am to 8pm

Exemptions are included on the no waiting at any time which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.

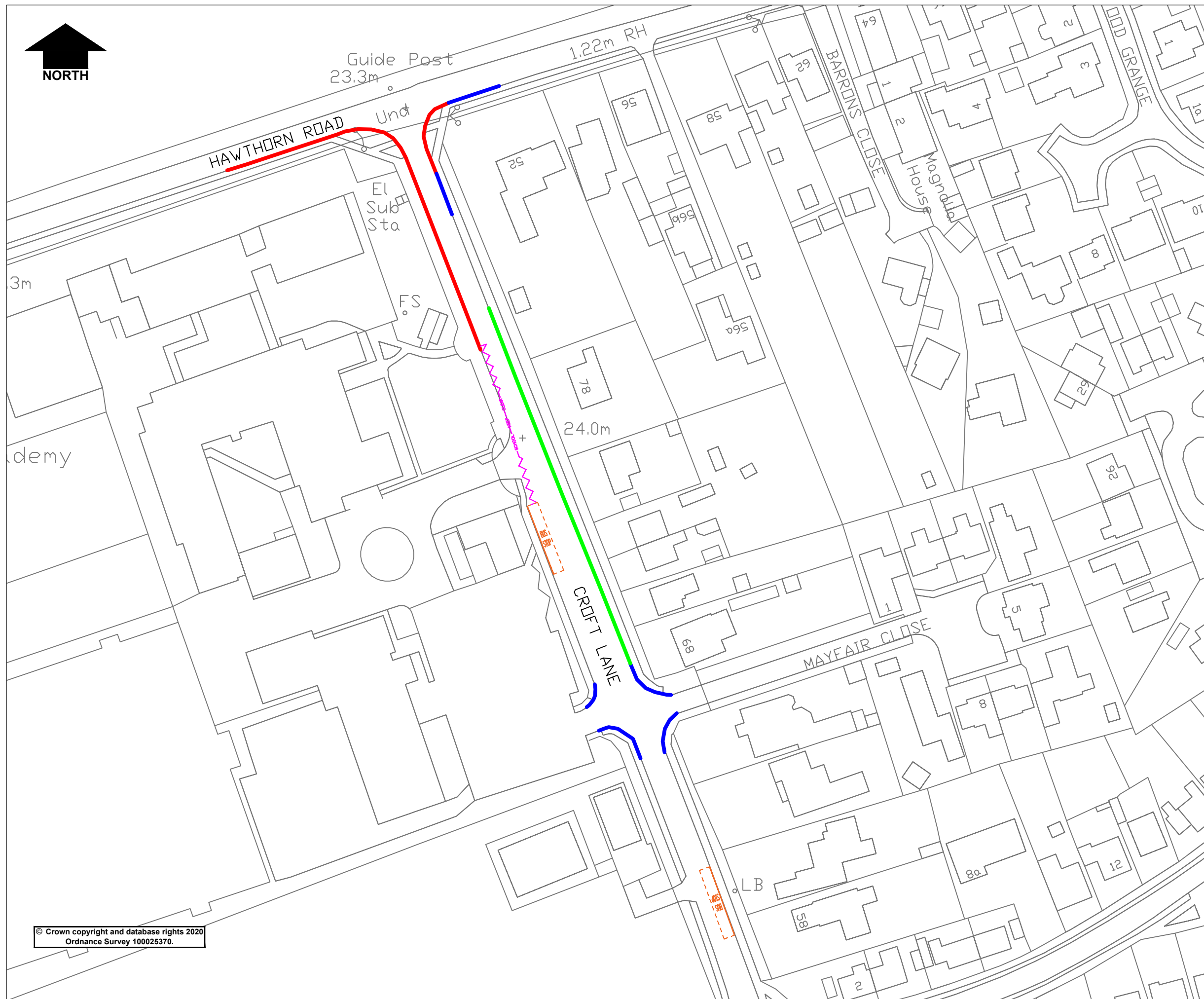

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of The Priory Pembroke Academy.
- The current restrictions are advisory and therefore are not always adhered to, assessments have shown that inconsiderate parking is taking place at school pick-up and drop-off times. The inconsiderate parking is taking place in the advisory school safety zone and on various junctions causing visibility issues and safety concerns for all road users.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Cherry Willingham Parish Council and West Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
