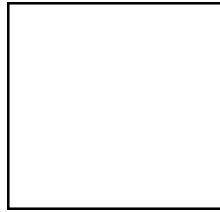


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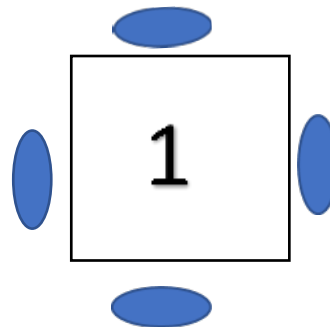
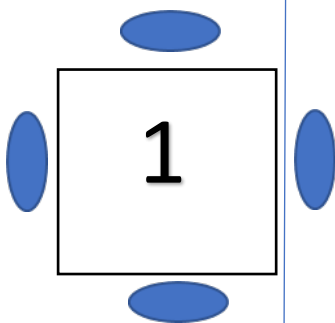
1. 2 large square tables 600mm diameter, 700mm high, each table with 4 aluminium wicker style chairs
