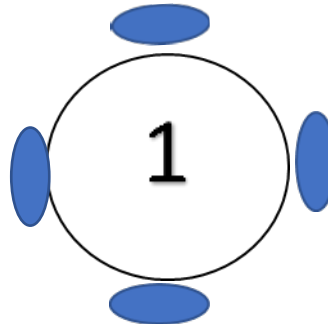
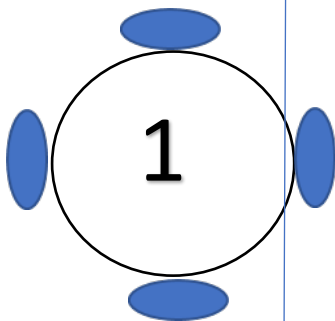
1. 2 large round tables 780mm diameter, 700mm high, each table with 4 wicker style chairs of aluminium construction.
2. 4 plastic planters (orange boxes) in metal racks on the wooden boundary fence planted with seasonal plant 500mm x 190mm
3. White painted wooden boundary fence secured to wall by hook and eye system to allow removal at the end of business.

Entrance

Raised window area within the confines of our boundary and not on the public area.

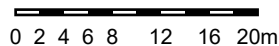
