Undertakings by the Lincolnshire County Council given to the Public Inquiry on the 12th February 2014 – 2nd Document

Introduction

During the Inquiry a number of undertakings have been proposed by the Lincolnshire County Council to address concerns raised by objectors. These are listed below by reference to each individual objector.

The Church Commissioners for England (represented by Mr L Humphries Smiths Gore)

- 1. Lincolnshire County Council undertakes that any land acquired from The Church Commissioners for England for a period of time but is not required to be retained permanently for the Scheme will in the first instance be offered back to The Church Commissioners for England. The County Council will undertake to return the land in a condition similar to that when acquired. The County Council undertakes not to seek to implement the Compulsory Purchase Order provided a mutually agreeable contract can be entered into.
- 2. With regard to Plot 2\3A, the County Council require the land and that is accepted by the Church Commissioners. The County Council are willing to work with the Church Commissioners in terms of how the works are to be carried out including finished levels and the amount of material that is to be deposited and both parties will investigate the possibility of some of the material being deposited elsewhere including in Greetwell Quarry, subject to any regulatory constraints. The County Council will make all reasonable efforts to secure any permissions necessary. The County Council will undertake to return the land in a condition similar to that when acquired.
- 3. With regard to the layout of the proposed development access where it connects to Bloxholm Lane, the County Council also undertakes to continue to liaise with the Church Commissioners during the detail design development of the LEB to ensure that the layout is constructed to the satisfaction of both parties.

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- 5. With regard to Plot 2\3A, the County Council require the land and that is accepted by the Church Commissioners. - 6. The County Council undertakes that the water main diversion under the Bypass will be designed to water industry standards. The detailed design of the diversion will be developed as the Scheme is carried forward.
