
PUBLIC NOTICE

LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (NETTLETON - A46 & NETTLETON ROAD) (40MPH & 50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to reduce the 50mph speed limit to 40mph through the village of Nettleton. The remainder of the 50mph speed limit in the vicinity will remain and will be included in the Order.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- The County Council is looking to pursue speed limit reductions at the above locations and as outlined on the attached plans. This follows recent concern and road traffic collisions along this stretch.
- Both proposals are in line with the County Councils policy.
- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to introduce a 40mph speed limit as per the schedule in the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Nettleton Parish Council and West Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
