## **Lincolnshire County Council Permit Scheme Order 2016**

Lincolnshire County Council in exercise of its powers conferred by section 33A (2) and Part 3 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers has made the above order.

Under section 17(1) of The Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) Regulations 2007, as amended by the Traffic Management Permit Scheme (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015, Lincolnshire County Council are required to notify you that The Lincolnshire Permit Scheme will come into effect on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2016.

From this date Lincolnshire County Council will commence operating a permit scheme on all publicly maintained roads within its authority boundary, as set out in the Schedule to the Order.
