1.	Have you reviewed your fire risk assessment in light of the current situation and acted upon any significant findings?		You should take into account changes to staffing levels and working practices which might impact upon how your business operates and affect your fire safety planning: 1. 2. 3.
2.	Is the fire alarm system suitable for the premises and in full working order?		If you or other persons have started to sleep on site as a result of the current situation you should assess whether the fire warning system is suitable for this and undertake any remedial action 1. 2. 3.
3.	Have you got adequate Emergency Lighting within the premises and is it in full working order?		If your business operates or people are on site during the hours of darkness you should assess the need for Emergency Lighting to ensure that means of escape can be used at all times 1. 2. 3.
4.	Is your fire fighting equipment of the correct type for the risks present and in the correct location?		You should ensure that any fire fighting equipment (extinguishers, blankets etc.) are of the correct type for the risks posed and placed in the correct locations for immediate safe use 1. 2. 3.
5.	Are all escape routes clear of obstructions and easily accessible?		You should regularly follow all escape routes to ensure that they have not become blocked or restricted by obstructions and that in an emergency all doors open easily without the use of keys or codes. All escape routes should lead to a place of safety 1. 2. 3.
6.	Are your tests of fixed wiring up to date and are you maintaining testing of your portable electrical equipment?		Your periodic safety check of all fixed wiring should still be maintained where possible and you should minimise the risk of portable electric equipment starting fires. One way of achieving this





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		is by PAT testing.
