Guide for site visitors during the COVID-19 pandemic.

During this time we are committed to preventing the spread of the Coronavirus and to protecting the health, safety and welfare of our employees, customers and visitors.

As such only business critical visitors are permitted to enter the site at this time.

## **COVID-19 summary**

Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) is an infectious disease. The coronavirus spreads primarily through droplets of saliva or discharge from the nose when an infected person coughs or sneezes.

#### Symptoms and illness

The main symptoms of coronavirus are:

- high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **new, continuous cough** this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Most people with coronavirus have at least one of these symptoms. If you have symptoms of coronavirus infection, however mild, you must not visit our site.

#### **Duty of Care**

We have considered appropriate controls to protect our staff, customers and other visitors from foreseeable hazards: including Coronavirus. The following measures stipulate key controls present at this site following a risk assessment. You must familiarise yourself with these controls and take any precautions outlined.

### **COVID-19 Controls - Core Principles**

At the heart of our control measures is the requirement to maintain social distancing (Keep a distance of 2 metres from all employees/ staff and other visitors), and to ensure high standards of personal hygiene.

# **COVID-19 Visitor Site Safety Measures**

For your safety, and to protect our employees, customers and other site visitors, we have introduced new controls at this site.

Handwashing	Hand wash stations have been provided at entrances and exits. Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds using soap and water, dry your hands with the disposable paper towel provided upon entry and exit, and after to touching your face or visiting the toilet etc.
Social	You must maintain a 2 metre distance from all persons at all times.

	If you are unable to comply (i.e. manual handling of heavy package) you must first report this to a site manager and subsequently implement safe precautions.
Movement on site	To enable social distancing and reduce footfall in high movement zones, we have introduced a directional flow system on site.
	e.g. Vehicles must follow the <b>brown</b> directional arrows to move around the site.
	Please park at the parking area closest to your destination.
	e.g. People must follow <b>blue</b> directional arrows attached to walls to move around the buildings.
