

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER

PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2020**

The above Order made on 23 October 2020 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish the whole width of part of Public Footpath No.76 in the parish of Waddingham running from OSGR SK 9845 9634 (A) in a generally south south easterly direction for approximately 47 metres to terminate at OSGR SK 9847 9630 (B). The total length of footpath to be extinguished to be approximately 47 metres as shown between points A-B on Order drawing numbered 2020/023/PPO364/A4.

The Order and drawing have been displayed in the ground floor reception window to allow viewing from outside the building only. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

If no representations or objections are duly made or if any so made are withdrawn Lincolnshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

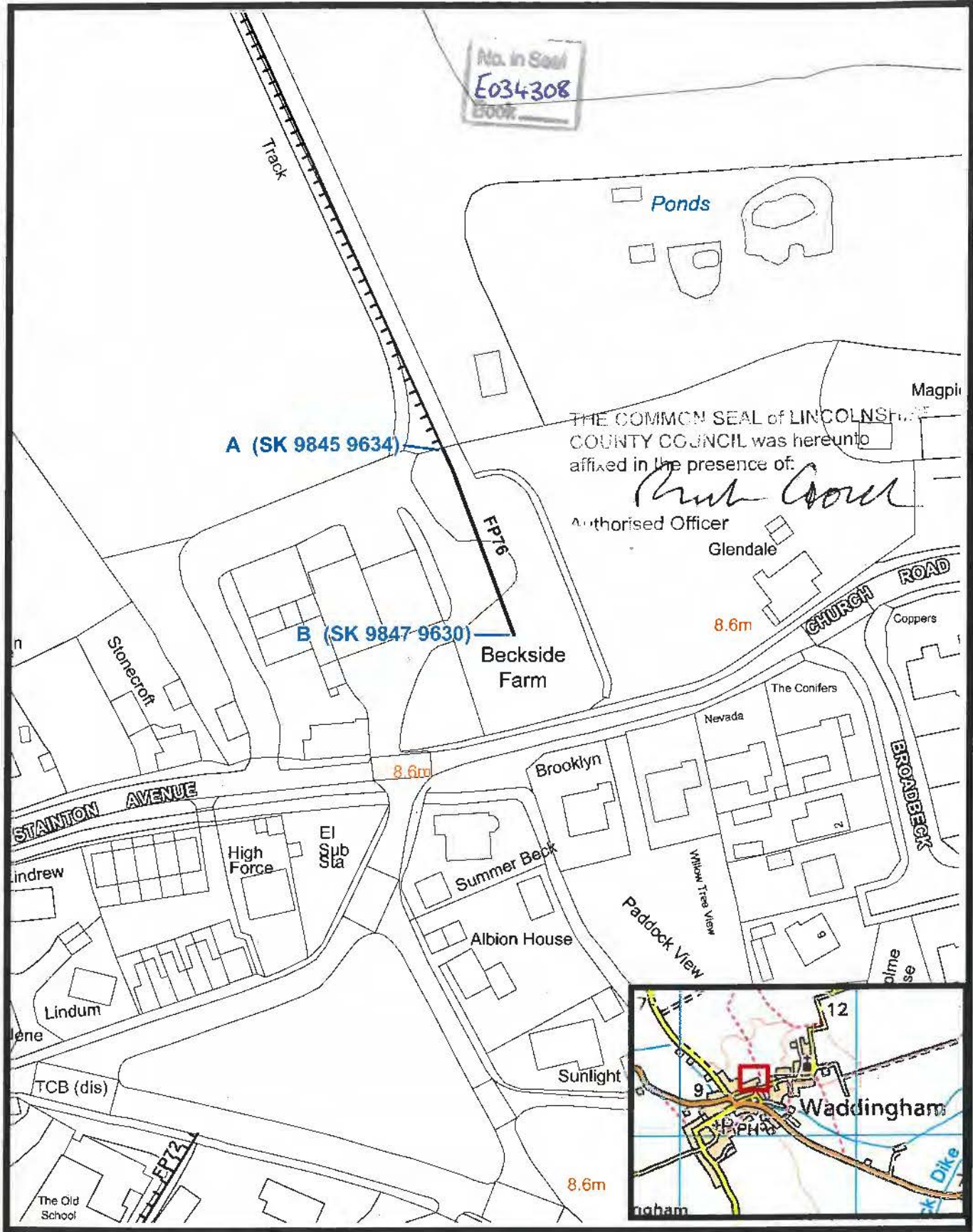

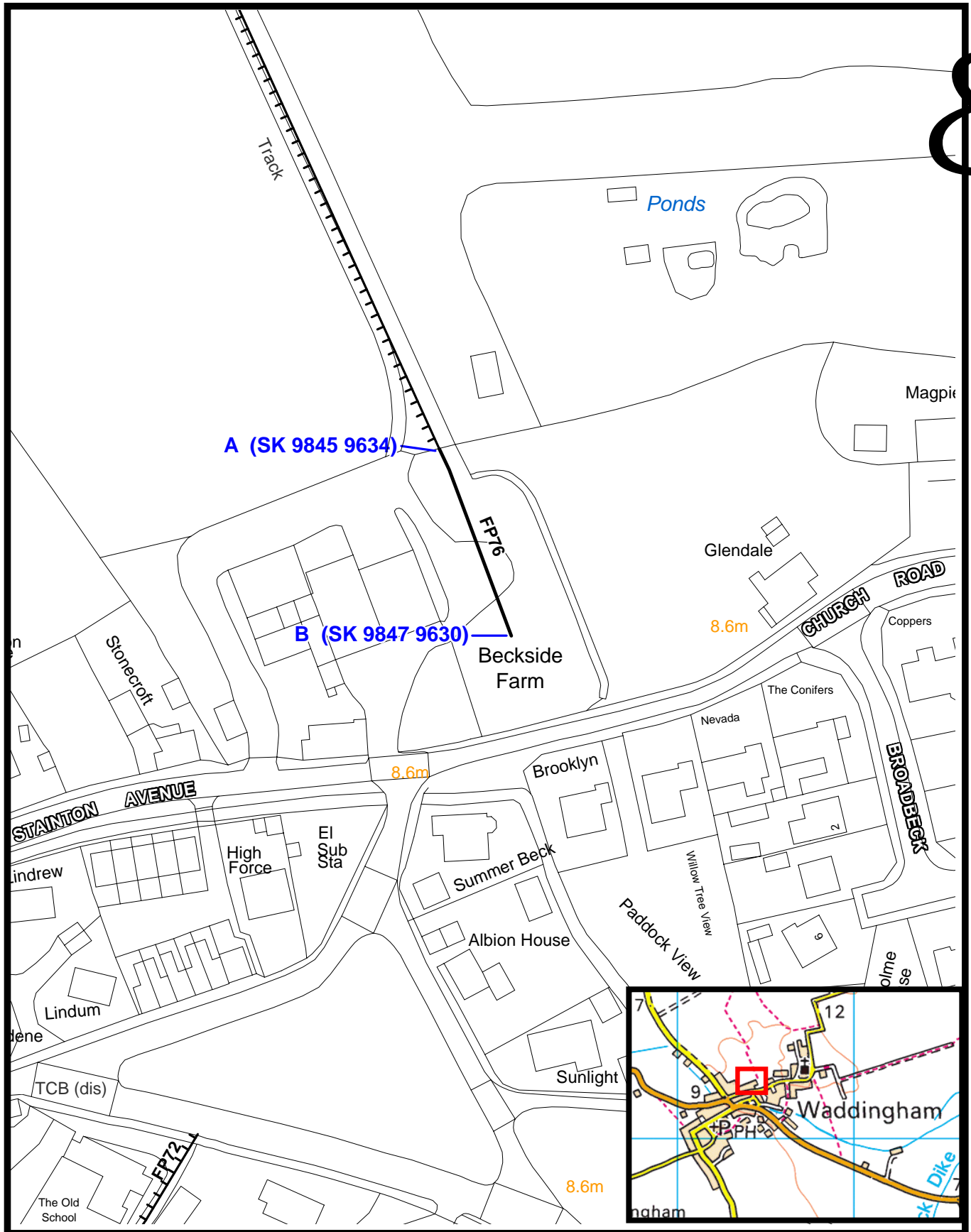
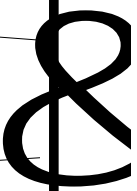
