ADDITION OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH NUMBER 1147 MIDDLE RASEN DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

This Order is made by Lincolnshire County Council ("the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to the Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the area of the former Lindsey County Council (Rural District of Caistor) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates


