STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the parking situation in the vicinity of Thorpe on The Hill Church of England Primary School.

- Therefore, in accordance with the County Council's Policy, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the Plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Thorpe on The Hill Par Council and North Kesteven
 District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.
