hereby apply for an order under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the Lincolnshire Definitive Map and Statement for the District of of East Lindsey by

- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Thornton from point **C** on Thornton 161/1 to point **D** on Thornton Ox Pasture Lane
- Upgrading the footpath known as Langton By Horncastle 161/1 in the parish of Langton By Horncastle to a bridleway from point **A** on Main Road to point **B** on the Thornton Parish boundary.
- Upgrading the footpath known as Thornton 161/1 in the parish of Thornton to a bridleway from point **B** on the Langton Parish boundary to point **C** on Thornton 161/1 as shown on the map
