- Adding a bridleway in the parish of Old Somerby from point **B** to the Little Ponton parish boundary at point **C** and then to point **D** on the bridleway Little Ponton 1/1
- Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath known as Old Somerby 6/1 from point **A** on Grantham Road, Old Somerby village to point **B**
