DECLARATION OF RIGHTS OF WAY - GUNBY HALL

On behalf of the National Trust, I am writing to make a declaration under section 31(6) of the Highways Act 1980, in respect of the National Trust's Gunby Hall estate which falls within your Council's boundary.

I declare that at the date of this letter, the only paths crossing the above estate that have been dedicated as highways and are therefore the only existing public rights of way, are those shown in yellow on the plans attached, being sections of footpath numbers 228,230,231,236,379,240 and 239 and Bridleway 232. Detail of the section of footpath 230 near Massingberd Arms Farm is shown on the 1:2500 plan attached.
