

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(SKEGNESS - RICHMOND DRIVE & DENHAM CLOSE )**

**(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) AMENDMENT ORDER 2025**

THE LINCOLNSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2(1) and (2), 3, 4, 5, 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act of 1984) as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (the Act of 2004) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on 20 and may be cited as the Lincolnshire County Council (Skegness – Richmond Drive & Denham Close) (Prohibition of Waiting) Amendment Order 2025
2. The Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 Plans including the key (the 'Plans') are incorporated into this Order.
3. Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

- Lincolnshire County Council recently received a request to review the waiting restrictions in the vicinity of The Richmond Primary Academy.
- Investigations have shown that although the advisory School Safety Zone is adhered to, cars are parking in the grass verges obstructing visibility for the school crossing patrol to operate in a safe manner. It was also noted that inconsiderate and dangerous parking is occurring at the junctions close to the school causing safety concerns for all road users.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.
- The Chief Constable, Skegness Town Council and East Lindsey District Council have been consulted, along with other local groups/companies.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Lincolnshire County Council propose to make an Order under their powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting as set out in the Schedule below:

- Introduce no loading Mon – Fri 8-9:30am & 2.30-4pm on Denham Close
- Introduce mandatory school keep clear Mon – Fri 8-9:30am & 2.30-4pm outside the entrances to The Richmond Primary Academy
- Introduce No Waiting at Any Time at the junctions of Denham Close, William Way and a private access
- Introduce No Waiting and No loading Mon – Fri 8-9:30am & 2.30-4pm in the vicinity of properties 50-56 Richmond Drive on both sides of the carriageway
- Introduce No Waiting Mon – Fri 8-9:30am & 2.30-4pm in the vicinity of properties 58-62 and 33-39 Richmond Drive.

Some exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
