- Plan ? of the Lincolnshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2012 shall be amended.
- 4. Any restriction or requirement made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or any other enactment is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the length and sides of road specified in this Order.

5. The prohibition imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

- Concerns have been expressed with regards to parking in the vicinity of the school. The advisory school keep clear markings are not being adhered to and as they are currently in the wrong location will be replaced in a more appropriate location.
- Vehicles have regularly been observed parking inconsiderately resulting in difficulties for all road users and raising safety concerns, particularly at the junction of West Street and Chapel Street and along Chapel Street.
- The school bus has problems safely parking due to vehicles parking close to the school entrance, so a designated bay is being proposed.
- The proposals will facilitate traffic flow, ensure all accesses are kept clear and improve visibility and road safety for all users.
- Therefore, it is proposed to prohibit waiting as set out on the plans to the Order.

- To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions fronting the school and at the junction of West Street and Chapel Street and along Chapel Street including junction with High Street.
- To introduce no waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-9am & 3pm-4pm restrictions on West Street opposite the junction of Chapel Street and adjacent to the school.
- To introduce no stopping Mon-Fri 8.30am-9am & 3pm-4pm except buses bay fronting the school.

Exemptions are included which will permit waiting for disabled persons' vehicles and for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading of goods, the maintenance of the roads, and works in connection with the supply of gas, electricity, water and telecommunications apparatus.
